CANCELLATION POLICY

DAY 1: ARRIVE IN LONDON

MONDAY, MAY 18

Begin your journey as you depart from Tampa on an overnight transatlantic flight to magnificent London.

DAY 2: SALISBURY & STONEHENGE

TUESDAY, MAY 19

Morning arrival in London. Your visit to England begins as you drive through the English countryside to Salisbury with its 404-foot cathedral spire. Continue to Stonehenge, one of the most famous prehistoric monuments in the world.

End the day in Bath after checking in to your comfortable hotel.

DAY 3: ROMAN BATHS & SHAKESPEARE

WEDNESDAY, MAY 20

After breakfast visit the nearby Roman baths. The city of Bath with its spa and natural hot springs has been famous for nearly 2,000 years. Continue to Stratford-upon-Avon to visit Shakespeare's birthplace & school. See the location of the Royal Shakespeare Company, a troupe that has produced many famous actors. Conclude the day in the historic university town of Oxford. (B)

DAY 4: OXFORD & BLENHEIM PALACE

THURSDAY, MAY 21

Enjoy a walking tour of Oxford's 900 year-old university. Its stunning architecture has made it a popular filming location the Harry Potter series and other projects. Visit places associated with The Inklings including C.S. Lewis and Tolkien's burial sites. Visit Lewis' home "The Kilns." Go to magnificent Blenheim Palace, Winston Churchill's birthplace to explore the grounds and enjoy a full afternoon tea before returning to your Oxford hotel. (B)

DAY 5: COTSWOLDS

FRIDAY, MAY 22

Spend a delightful day in the Cotswolds, a village district untouched by the Industrial Era. See thatched-roof houses, gardens, rolling fields, and gentle rivers as you explore this rural side of England, which has inspired writers for generations. You will have time in 3 different villages to explore, eat, and shop. Arrive in London and check into your hotel to finish the day. (B)

DAY 6: LONDON & WESTMINSTER ABBEY

SATURDAY, MAY 23

Your morning tour of London takes you to Trafalgar Square, the Thames Embankment, past the Houses of Parliament and Big Ben, along Whitehall and to Buckingham Palace. Visit 1,000 year-old Westminster Abbey, the burial place of famous men and women including monarchs, authors & poets. Round off the day with an entertaining and historical tour of the Tower of London. Balance of the evening is free to attend a West End show, relax, or explore the city as you wish. (B)

DAY 7: BRITISH LIBRARY & MORE

SUNDAY, MAY 24

After morning worship enjoy a private "Treasures tour" of the British Library. See handwritten works from Mozart, Leonardo da Vinci and Lennon/McCartney, ancient biblical manuscripts, Jane Austin's writing desk, an original Shakespeare folio, and more. Balance of the afternoon and evening is free to enjoy London. (B)

DAY 8: WINDSOR & HARRY POTTER TOUR

TUESDAY, MAY 25

Tour Windsor Castle, an active royal residence for King Charles II. Might any of the Royal family be in attendance while you're there? After lunch drive to Warner Brothers Studios for a "Harry Potter" tour featuring original sets, costumes and props from the famous films. Return to London to enjoy the balance of the evening. (B)

DAY 11: RETURN HOME **THURSDAY, MAY 28**

This wonderful tour concludes in your return flight to Tampa. Arrive home with memories to enjoy for years to come. (B)

DAY 9: BRITISH MUSEUM & GLOBE THEATRE

MONDAY, MAY 26

Visit the British Museum, home to many world archaeological treasures from ancient Egypt, Israel, Assyria, Babylon, Greece, and Rome. After lunch enjoy a tour of Shakespeare's Globe Theatre. Stroll the Abbey Road crosswalk? Shop on Oxford Street? Catch one more show? Take a Sherlock Holmes tour? London holds countless options significant to literature, film, history, and the arts! (B)
